We expect to have a great time - but we need students to **follow instructions**. This is a **group tour** and not a family holiday.

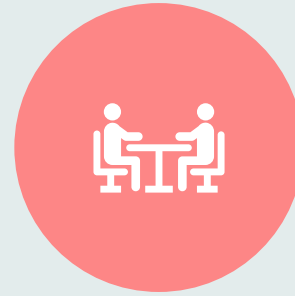
Balconies are out of bounds.
